

## Dogs SA Height Card Protocol

To compete in official Agility Trials, you need to have your dog measured in accordance with ANKC Agility rule 4.3. <a href="https://dogsaustralia.org.au/media/9706/1-agility-and-games-rules-combined-01-01-21v2.pdf">https://dogsaustralia.org.au/media/9706/1-agility-and-games-rules-combined-01-01-21v2.pdf</a>

To arrange for your dog to be measured you first need to contact the nominated member of the Agility Advisory Committee (AAC). The name of this person can be found on the Agility SA website. The contact email is heightcardaac@gmail.com

Please complete this form and forward it to the nominated AAC person. Except for country competitors this should be done prior to entering a trial. All dogs are required to have a official height card prior to competing.

The AAC contact person will then arrange a date, time and venue for you to attend to undertake the measurement. To be measured accurately your dog needs to be able to stand steadily.

Please ensure that if your dog is under joint ownership e.g. a spouse that both owners are financial members DogsSA or an equivalent ANKC canine control body, prior to trialling so any subsequent qualifications are legitimate.
