Follow up will occur with the dog's owner at a later date, to obtain further information as to the nature of the treatment required and the time needed for recovery.

*Reports will be added to an injury database for compilation of statistics over time. **This data will be deidentified.** The name of the owner, dog or judge will not be retained once the data is complete. The DogsSA registration number will be used as an identifier. For this data to be useful it is important that the information is accurate, detailed and timely.*
